**NOTICE OF CLOSURE OF THE FLATHEAD FISHERY IN RESPECT OF THE ACTIVITY OF FILLETING
FLATHEAD**

I, Dr David Midson, General Manager (Marine Resources) in the Department of Natural Resources and Environment Tasmania, acting pursuant to a delegation from the Minister for Primary Industries and Water hereby determine under rule 11 of the *Fisheries (Scalefish) Rules 2015* (the Rules) that all that part of the scalefish fishery for all species of flathead is closed in respect of the filleting of flathead in State waters and this determination commences at 12:01 am 1 March 2026 and continues until this notice is revoked.

Any expression used in this notice having a particular meaning under the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* (the Act) or the Rules has the same meaning in this notice.
