

LIVING MARINE RESOURCES MANAGEMENT ACT 1995
SECTION 75 - MINISTERIAL GUIDELINE

SUBJECT: CONDITIONS APPLYING TO FISHING LICENCES (ABALONE QUOTA) COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS THE "FURNEAUX LICENCES".

This guideline replaces the guideline dated 26 November 1998.

OBJECTIVES:

To reaffirm the conditions applying to the 5 fishing licences (abalone quota) commonly known as the "Furneaux licences".

POLICY STATEMENT:

The following conditions will continue to apply to the 5 fishing licences (abalone quota) listed below.

1. The licences are non-transferable.
2. The units held under the licences must be caught by the holder of the licence.
3. The licences must be surrendered when the holder ceases to be a licensed abalone diver.
