## Project Description

The company aims to upscale and modernise their processing capability improving product quality and process. This grant will support the installation and refurbishment of processing infrastructure such as a cryovac machine, modified atmosphere packaging equipment, pin-boning equipment and meat dicer.

New seafood processing equipment will allow the company to increase production output and overcome production bottlenecks, extend shelf life and diversify product range. This will increase production of value-added products including fish stocks, terrines and smoked products.

These positive changes will allow access to new markets, including food service companies and exports to the mainland, and improve the businesses resilience, adding value to the Tasmanian seafood industry.
