NOTICE - DECLARATION OF PROTECTED FISH

I, GAVIN PEARCE, Minister for Primary Industries and Water, the Minister administering the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* (the Act), acting pursuant to section 135 of the Act, hereby declare the species of fish specified in Schedule 1 to be protected.

SCHEDULE 1

Species of protected fish

Keyhole limpet

Limpet of any of the superfamilies Fissurelloidea, Patelloidea, or Siphonarioidea

Orange-edged limpet (*Cellana solida*)

Pipehorse, pipefish, seahorse, or seadragon of the family Syngnathidae

Handfish of the family Brachionichthyidae

Great white shark (*Carcharodon carcharias*)

Basking shark (*Cetorhinus maximus*)

Grey nurse shark (*Carcharias taurus*)

Megamouth shark (*Megachasma pelagios*)

Whale shark (*Rhincodon typus*)

Notes:

1. Any expression used in this instrument bearing a particular meaning under the Act or the Rules made under the Act has the same meaning in this instrument.
2. A person must not take any protected fish unless that person is exempt from compliance with this declaration pursuant to section 11 of the Act.
3. The penalty for taking any protected fish is a fine not exceeding 500 penalty units.
